On May 16 we celebrated our Golf partners from the Black Rock Sports Auxiliary (BRSA) and the Royal Melbourne Golf Club by acknowledging them as Paul Harris Fellows. Graham Ludecke, OAM and Malcolm Brand, both from BRSA, and Aaron Newnham, Operations Manager at the Royal Melbourne Golf Club were most worthy recipients as Paul Harris Fellows. History of the Black Rock Sport Auxiliary and RC Beaumaris Collaboration.

The Bayside Charity Golf Day has been jointly run by the Black Rock Sports Auxiliary Inc (BRSA) and the Rotary Club of Beaumaris (RCOB) since 2018.

BRSA, established in 1960, held their first Charity Golf Day at Royal Melbourne in 1952 to support the establishment of the Sandringham Hospital, and thereafter the equipment for the Sandringham Hospital.

From the 1980s, Beaumaris Rotary has held their annual Bayside Mayoral Charity Golf Day at Royal Melbourne for the benefit of the many charities we support, including the Sandringham Hospital.

With the generous support of Royal Melbourne Golf Club, we have jointly contributed over \$4.5 million (in today's dollars) to Sandringham Hospital and this year we expect to raise about \$120,000 from the day. There are 372 players registered for both the East and West courses for our Charity Golf Day on Monday May 20th.

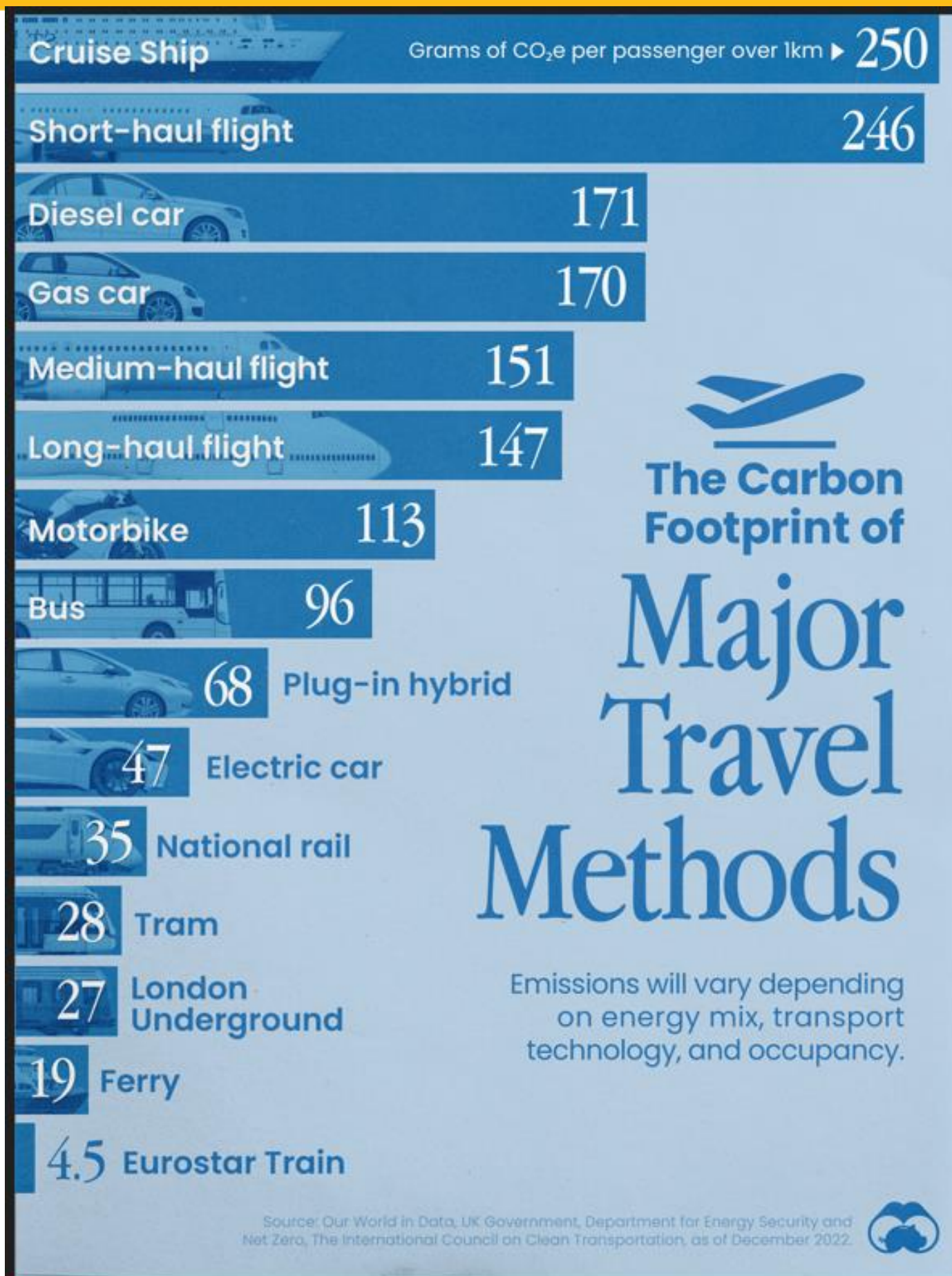
